Filters break down into microplastics that stay in the environment.

Filters do not make cigarettes safer, they just make it easier to sell cigarettes Filters biodegrade, so they do not harm the environment.

> Filters protect people who smoke from toxic chemicals in cigarettes.

Cleanups show the extent of filter waste but cannot remove all of them.

Community cleanups are the most effective way to get rid of filters.
